- {¶ 2} On February 25, 2021, the Commission granted CIS Energy a certificate (Certificate No. 21-052166E) to operate as a CRES provider.
- $\{\P 3\}$ On January 18, 2023, CIS Energy filed its renewal application, which it amended on February 7, 2023.
- {¶ 4} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10(A) provides that an application shall be deemed automatically approved pursuant to R.C. 4928.08 upon the 31st day after the official filing date. Further, Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10(A) provides that, upon good cause shown, an attorney examiner may suspend its consideration of an application.
- $\{\P 5\}$ The attorney examiner finds that, in order for the Commission and its Staff to further review this matter, CIS Energy's application should be suspended until the Commission specifically orders otherwise.
