### ENTRY

Entered in the Journal on February 21, 2023

{¶ 1} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.10, by Entry issued January 26, 2022, the Commission directed all regulated entities to file a 2021 annual report for fiscal assessment through the PUCO Community, the Commission's web-based filing system, by April 29, 2022. The Commission uses the annual report information to generate invoices that are then sent to the annual report filers on or before the first day of October consistent with R.C. 4905.10(B) to fund the operations of the Commission.

{¶ 2} On October 26, 2022, Infinity Power Partners LLC (Infinity Powers) filed a motion for leave to amend its retail natural gas broker and electric aggregator annual reports for calendar year 2021. However, this filing was considered defective by the Commission, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-08, which directs corporations to be represented by counsel during Commission proceedings.

{¶ 3} Thereafter, on February 10, 2023, Infinity Powers filed a motion for leave to amend its retail natural gas broker and electric aggregator annual reports for calendar year 2021.

{¶ 4} Infinity Powers asserts it is authorized to provide retail natural gas broker services pursuant to Certificate No. 13-321G and to provide electric aggregator services pursuant to Certificate No. 15-1010E. In its correspondence, Infinity Powers notes that its kilowatt (electric) and therms (gas) usage, instead of revenues, were reported on the annual reports. Infinity Powers requests that they be permitted to amend and correctly report the company's revenues. Upon approval of this motion and the unlocking of the 2021 annual

report in the PUCO Community, Infinity Powers commits to promptly submit the 2021 annual reports.

{¶ 5} The attorney examiner determines that Infinity Power's February 10, 2023 motion for leave to amend its annual reports for calendar year 2021 should be granted. Infinity Powers is directed to contact the Commission's Fiscal Division to make arrangements to submit its corrections to their 2021 annual reports for fiscal assessment.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the motion filed by Infinity Powers be granted in accordance with Paragraph 5. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon Infinity Powers.
