EXAMINER DAVIS: Good afternoon,
everyone. Thanks for being here despite that no one
will be testifying. I'm just going to go over sort
of a brief preamble, set out the purpose of the
hearing, and then I'll open the floor for a minute.
And if no one changes their mind, then that will be
it. But thanks again for bearing with me.

The Public Utilities Commission has
scheduled for hearing at this time and place Case
No. 22-1025-AU-COI which is captioned in the Matter
of the Commission's Investigation into the
Implementation of the Federal Infrastructure
Investment and Jobs Act's Electric Vehicle Charging
PURPA Standard.

My name Jesse Davis. I am the Attorney
Examiner assigned by the Commission to hear this
case.

The subject of today's public hearing is
the implementation of one of the programs under the
Federal IIJA of 2021, amendment -- the amendment to
the Public Utility Regulatory Policy Act, herein
after referred as PURPA, specifically the amendment

1 to the EV charging standards.

2 The purpose of the hearing is to solicit
3 public feedback of any flavor on the implementation
4 of the EV charging standards which would be taken
5 into consideration as the Commission sort of does its
6 evaluation of the standard.

7 This hearing is being held pursuant to 21
8 USC 2621(b) (1). I'll note that this is not a
9 question and answer session but an opportunity to
10 offer any information you feel the Commission should
11 consider in its deliberations as to the possible
12 imple -- implementation of the EV charging standard.

13 Further, following today's public
14 hearing, the Commission could and may enter
15 additional orders and filings but not necessarily in
16 this case docket. If you are interested in following
17 sort of the overarching IIJA docket, that number is
18 22-755-AU-COI.

19 Today's hearing is being transcribed by a
20 court reporter. If you do plan to ultimately
21 comment, please speak clearly so the court reporter
22 can accurately reflect your comments on the record.

23 The Commission appreciates your
24 participation should you choose to participate in
25 today's hearing. We want everyone who intends to

1 comment to be heard and given the opportunity to do
2 so.

3 We have no one signed up to testify, so I
4 will just open the floor for half a second here. If
5 anybody just changed their mind, you are free to come
6 up to the Bench and speak. But if not, then I will
7 adjourn.

8 So going once, twice, sold. Thank you
9 all again for being here. We appreciate it. The
10 Commission appreciates you taking the time to come
11 out. That would be it. And again, if you wish to,
12 you can go onto our Docketing Information System
13 website, you can sign up for alerts if there is
14 anything you would like to follow in any of the IIJA
15 dockets.
