{¶ 1} Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke or the Company) is an electric distribution utility as defined in R.C 4928.01(A)(6), and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 2} Pursuant to the directives of R.C. 4928.143(F), the Commission is required to evaluate the earnings of each electric utility's approved electric security plan to determine whether the plan or offer produces significantly excessive earnings for the electric utility.

{¶ 3} On May 12, 2022, Duke filed an application for the administration of the significantly excessive earnings test, as required by R.C. 4928.143(F) and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-35-10 for 2021.

{¶ 4} The attorney examiner now finds it appropriate to set a procedural schedule in this matter, as follows:

- (1) Motions to intervene shall be filed by April 7, 2023;
- (2) Any stipulations shall be filed by June 6, 2023, and should indicate whether a hearing is necessary; and,
- If necessary, a hearing shall convene on June 15, 2023, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-D, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That the procedural schedule set forth in Paragraph 4 be adopted.It is, further,
