- March 28, 2023 the board resolved that Oak Run would fail to serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity as required by Ohio law.

These documents WILL NOT STOP Oak Run Solar project from the OPSB proceedings. Those whom oppose Oak Run Solar project should continue to oppose through and by the OPSB proceedings, with the OPSB Oak Run Solar project public hearing and through public comments.
