Entered in the Journal on April 17, 2023

{¶ 1} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory. Additionally, pursuant to R.C. 4928.16, the Commission has jurisdiction under R.C. 4905.26, upon complaint of any person, regarding the provision by an electric services company subject to certification under R.C. 4928.08 of any service for which it is subject to certification.

{¶ 2} Eligo Energy OH, LLC (Eligo) is certified to provide competitive retail electric service under R.C. 4928.08 and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission pursuant to R.C. 4928.16.

{¶ 3} On October 21, 2022, Joseph Codispoti and Alexandra Mougianis (Complainants) initiated a complaint against Eligo alleging that Eligo overcharged them on their bills during May and June of 2022 where their contract with Eligo expired in February 2022 and thereafter they were being charged a rate higher than AEP Ohio's price to compare, which at the time was \$0.072 per kilowatt hour.

{¶ 4} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(B), a copy of the complaint was mailed to Eligo on October 24, 2022. To date, Eligo has not filed an answer or responsive pleading in this case docket.

{¶ 5} At this time, Eligo is ordered to file its answer and any other responsive pleading in this matter within 20 days after receipt of this Entry.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the Commission's docketing division serve a copy of this Entry upon Eligo. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That Eligo comply with Paragraph 5. It is, further,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
