Customer Comments: "Hi - I would like to file a complaint with AEP as well as the Public Utility Commission for approving rate increases up to 30% for customers this summer. The increase comes at a time when AEP has following a controlled blackout last summer and at a time when hike increase is happening at a time when AEP has increased its quarterly dividends for shareholders up to 83 cents per share. With 514 million shares, that provides returns to shareholders of \$1.7 billion. Additionally, many people live in apartments and do not have the ability to "shop" around for energy providers."
