The Wellington Substation to Brighton Substation portion of the facility was energized and began commercial operation on June 21, 2023; the Beaver Substation to Brighton Substation portion of the facility was energized and began commercial operation on July 13, 2023.

Areas disturbed during construction will be restored as soon as practicable after construction is completed; restoration activities should be finished by December 2023. ATSI has complied with all construction related conditions of the certificate, as well as a timeline for the start of operations.

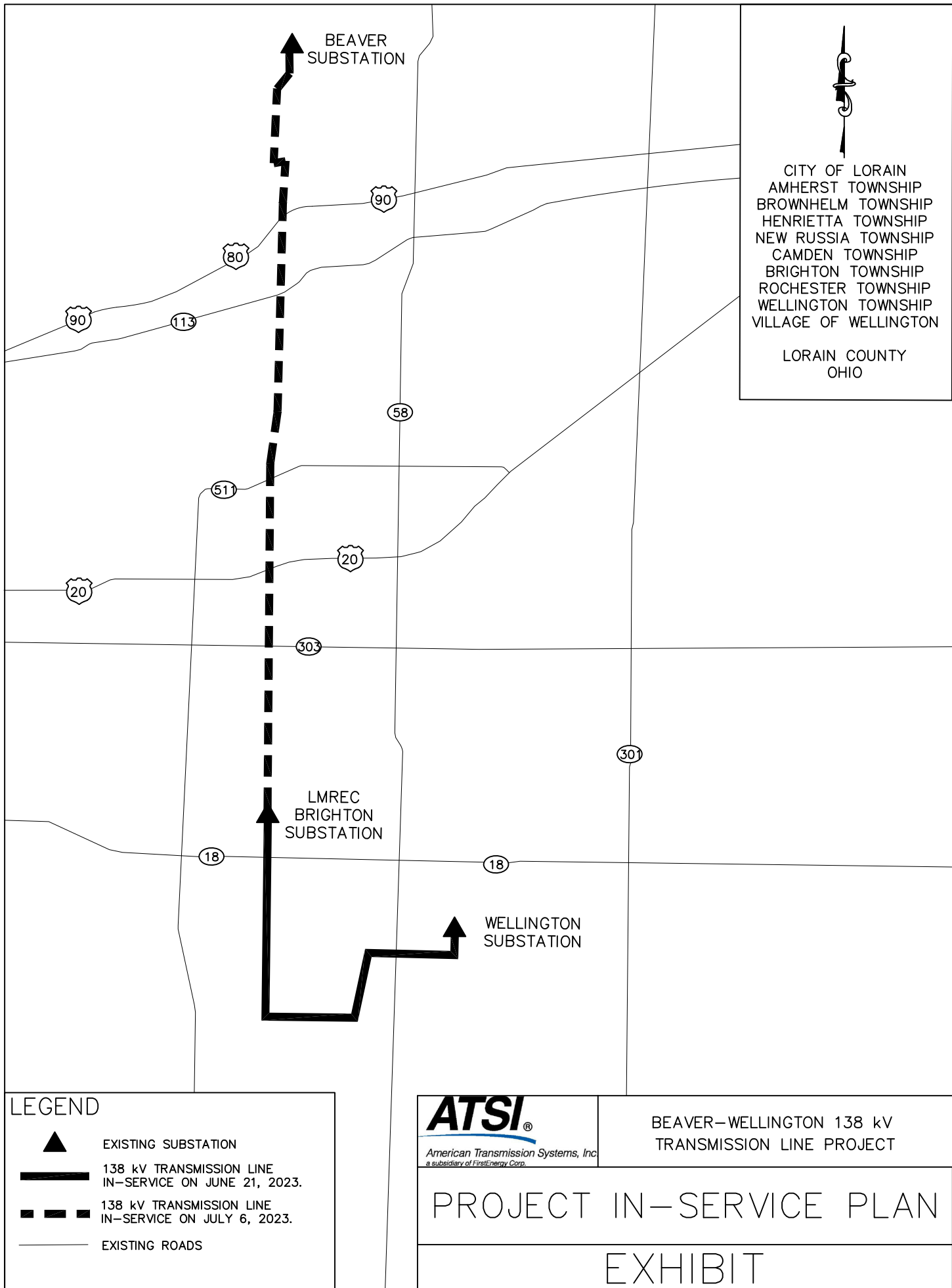

You can expect to receive confirmation of receipt within 1 business day.

Once a complaint has been received, it is forwarded to the ATSI project manager and/or transmission project staff. ATSI will promptly review and respond to written questions, concerns or grievances. All well-founded complaints reported by phone and email are referred to and investigated by ATSI’s transmission group. If the complaint is deemed to have merit based on the information presented, the project manager will determine mitigation or other resolution to be presented to the customer. If acceptable to the customer, the field staff is directed to execute resolution of the complaint. If the resolution is not acceptable to the customer, the customer should contact ATSI again to request for further investigation.
