## THE CLEVELAND ELECTRIC ILLUMINATING COMPANY'S REPORT REGARDING IMPROVED PROCESS FOR TRAINING OF IN-THE-FIELD EMPLOYEES

Pursuant to the Opinion and Order issued by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio on April 19, 2023 in the above captioned matter, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company ("CEI") submits this report regarding "certain improvements made to its training of in-the-field employees that emphasize the types of inspections needed for purported problems with secondary lines leading to residential service drops, along with a consistent reporting policy related to the results of such inspections."

CEI is taking the following steps:

- Develop a "National Electric Safety Code and Secondary Services Inspection Awareness Training Course" for all CEI line personnel.<sup>2</sup>
- Specific to this report, the training will address inspections for purported problems with secondary lines leading to residential service drops and the process for reporting the results of those inspections.
- The course will reaffirm how employees will inspect purported problems with secondary services, including without limitation through visual inspections of service drops for

conductor condition, as well as inspection of the connection point at the customer's premise.

- The course will also reaffirm the reporting process for employees, which includes communicating findings to the customer by making contact and/or leaving a door-hanger and reporting any findings to dispatch and to the employee's supervisor.
- CEI's training will commence in August 2023, with an expected completion in November 2023.<sup>3</sup>
- CEI management will deliver this initial training to line personnel during a morning standup or monthly safety meeting. The training is expected to last 20-30 minutes with time allowed for employees to ask questions.
- CEI management will track training completion results using the Companies' learning management system.
- Subsequently, this training will be an annual requirement for CEI line personnel. CEI management will deliver this yearly training during a morning standup or monthly safety meeting.
- Commencing on August 21, 2023, CEI will run bi-weekly reports confirming training completion. As of the training completion deadline in November 2023, the names of any employees who have not yet completed the training will be provided to Company leadership to ensure training completion by the end of the calendar year.
- The training course will be part of the onboarding process for new employees.
