Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-14(I), a local exchange carrier (LEC) must docket a zeroday notice filing (ZTA) with the Commission to amend its tariff, in accordance with the process set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-04, to introduce an expansion of a local service area.

On June 6, 2023, and as amended on June 8, 2023, Telephone Service Company (TSC) filed a zero-day notice filing to expand its local service area in its Cridersville and Wapakoneta exchanges. This expanded local service area will entitle the subscribers of these exchanges to call, without additional charge, subscribers in a larger group of surrounding exchanges. The staff reviewed all documents and exhibits submitted with this filing and finds that the TSC's filing satisfies all requirements the set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-04 and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-14(I).

In conclusion, staff recommends that this filing be permitted to remain in effect.
