On March 10, 2023, Youngstown & Southeastern Railroad (RR) filed a request for relocation and replacement of Warning Devices at their CR 32/Western Reserve Road, DOT#873-465W, grade crossing in Mahoning County, Ohio. On June 27, 2023, an Attorney Examiner Entry was issued asking Staff file a report in investigation no later than July 28, 2023.

Field Staff has indicated they will not be able to meet the request deadline for a report on this project. Staff has indicated the proposed plans have some complex, technical issues that require a discussion with the railroad. The plans involve traffic preemption, which involve interconnectivity with nearby traffic lights to clear vehicles that may que over the crossing. Thus, this project involves matters more complex than a standard light and gate project without a connection with traffic signals.

For these reasons, staff would like to request a 30 day extension to complete the report.
