## **ENTRY**

## Entered in the Journal on September 11, 2023

- {¶ 1} R.C. 121.95, as enacted on October 17, 2019, required state agencies, including the Commission, to create a base inventory of regulatory restrictions contained in each of their rules by December 31, 2019.
- $\{\P\ 2\}$  R.C. 121.951(A)(1), effective June 8, 2022, requires the Commission to amend or rescind rules identified in its base inventory—using the criteria listed in R.C. 106.03(A)—as necessary to reduce the total number of regulatory restrictions by thirty percent over the course of three years.
- $\{\P 3\}$  The Commission initiated this proceeding to conduct a review of the rules contained in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-13 and reduce the number of regulatory restrictions pursuant to R.C. 121.951(A)(1).
- {¶ 4} On October 5, 2022, after evaluating the rules, the Commission issued Staff's proposed amendments to the rules with a related Business Impact Analysis. The Commission's Entry also invited stakeholders to file comments regarding the proposed rules.
- {¶ 5} The Commission received initial comments from Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion Energy Ohio, and Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC). Reply comments were filed by OCC, The Ohio Gas Association, and Retail Energy Supply Association.

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{¶ 6} On December 14, 2022, the Commission issued its Finding and Order

adopting amendments to certain rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-13.

{¶ 7} Pursuant to the requirements of R.C. 111.15, the Commission filed the

proposed amendments to Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-13 with the Joint Committee on

Agency Rule Review (JCARR). JCARR's jurisdiction over the amendments to the rules

ended as of September 3, 2023.

{¶ 8} The amendments to the rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-13 will

become effective on September 18, 2023.

 $\{\P 9\}$  It is, therefore,

{¶ 10} ORDERED, That the amendments to the rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter

4901:1-13, adopted through this proceeding, be effective on September 18, 2023. It is, further,

**¶ 11** ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all regulated gas and

natural gas companies, the gas-pipeline service list, the Ohio Gas Association, the Ohio Oil

and Gas Association, OCC, and all other interested persons of record.
