Docketing Division:

AES Ohio hereby submits its updated proposed Tariff for modifying its Tax Savings Credit Rider ("TSCR") consistent with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's ("Commission") Finding and Order dated September 26, 2019, in Case No. 19-568-EL-ATA, et al. adopting the Stipulation and Recommendation ("the Stipulation") filed in that case. The TSCR was first implemented on October 1, 2019 and is to be annually trued-up in accordance with the Stipulation. If approved, this proposed tariff update will credit certain Distribution Revenue to customers over the next 12 months starting on November 1, 2023.

This filing includes a reconciliation from the November 2021 – October 2022 rate. The November 2022 – October 2023 rate will be reconciled with the next annual filing.

Consistent with the Commission's February 26, 2020 Second Finding and Order in Case No. 19-841-EL-RDR, a credit for the ongoing portion of the PUCO/OCC Assessment Fees recovered through the Standard Service Offer Rate are included in this rate.

Once approved by the Commission, the Final Tariff will then be docketed in this case and the Company's TRF docket before the effective date.

P.U.C.O. No. 17
ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SERVICE
TAX SAVINGS CREDIT RIDER

DESCRIPTION:

The Tax Savings Credit Rider is intended to refund the electric distribution share of benefits resulting from the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 that are not already reflected in rates.

APPLICABLE:

This Rider will be assessed as a percentage of base distribution charges on each monthly bill, effective on a bills-rendered basis for all Customers served under the Electric Distribution Tariff Sheets D17-D25.

CHARGES:

-1.9312% of base distribution charges

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The Tax Savings Credit Rider shall be adjusted annually to refund amounts authorized by the Commission. This Rider is subject to reconciliation, including but not limited to, refunds to customers, based upon the results of audits as approved and ordered by the Commission. Proposed tariffs will be automatically approved 60 days after filing or November 1, whichever is later, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
