{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Brian Jobe (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On January 5, 2022, Respondent requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} Respondent participated in a settlement conference with Staff on February 24, 2022, but the parties did not resolve the matter.

{¶ 4} Subsequent scheduling of a hearing was postponed several times because of scheduling conflicts, as well as continuation of settlement negotiations. The hearing was ultimately scheduled for September 26, 2023.

{¶ 5} The parties participated in the September 26, 2023 hearing as scheduled. Discussion following the hearing resulted in the parties agreeing to filing of briefs no later than November 3, 2023, and filing of reply briefs no later than November 17, 2023.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, that post-hearing briefs be filed no later than November 3, 2023, and reply briefs be filed no later than November 17, 2023. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
