The Dayton Power and Light Company d/b/a AES Ohio will soon begin construction of a new transmission substation facility, known as the Kiser Substation Interconnection Project, in Adams Township, Champaign County, Ohio. The Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) recommended automatic approval of AES Ohio's Letter of Notification regarding this Project for September 1, 2023.
