#### APPLICATION OF XIBER LLC FOR APPROVAL TO RELINQUISH ITS DESIGNATION AS A AS A HIGH-COST COMPETITIVE ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER

Pursuant to Section 214(e)(6) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended ("Act"), Section 54.201 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC) and Ohio Adm. Code 4901:1-9-09(D)(2), Xiber, LLC ("Xiber" or "Applicant") hereby requests that the Commission approve this Application to relinquish Xiber's Competitive Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") designation in the state of Ohio as soon as possible.

#### I. BACKGROUND

Xiber is a limited liability company organized in the state of Delaware. Its principal place of business is located at 3500 Depauw Boulevard, Suite 1042, Indianapolis, IN 46268. The Commission granted Xiber's application for designation as a High Cost Rural Competitive ETC in certain exchanges in Ohio on May 19, 2021, in Case No. 21-141-TP-UNC. Xiber sought designation as an ETC in connection with the Federal Communication Commission's ("FCC") Rural Digital Opportunity Fund ("RDOF") Phase I auction, in which Xiber's parent company, Hawaii Dialogix Telecom LLC ("HDT") was the provisionally selected by the FCC as a recipient of RDOF Phase I support for five census blocks and associated wire centers within the Ada, Alger and Kenton exchanges, all located in Hardin County, Ohio. HDT subsequently assigned its winning bid to Xiber.

Xiber is a subsidiary of Hawaii Dialogix Telecom LLC ("HDT"), a Delaware LLC with principal offices located at 3375 Koapaka Street, Suite B284, Honolulu, HI 96819. HDT holds a 93% ownership interest in Xiber.

#### II. ETC RELINQUISHMENT REQUIREMENTS

Xiber is entitled to relinquish its ETC designation pursuant to Section 214(e)(4) of the Act, which states, in pertinent part:

A State commission ... shall permit an eligible telecommunications carrier to relinquish its designation as such a carrier in any area served by more than one eligible telecommunications carrier. An eligible telecommunications carrier that seeks to relinquish its eligible telecommunications carrier designation for an area served by more than one eligible telecommunications carrier shall give advance notice to the State commission ... of such relinquishment. Prior to permitting a telecommunications carrier designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier to cease providing universal service in an area served by more than one eligible telecommunication ... shall require the remaining eligible telecommunications carrier or carriers to ensure that all customers served by the relinquishing carrier will continue to be served, and shall require sufficient notice to permit the purchase or construction of adequate facilities by any remaining eligible telecommunications carrier.

47 CFR 54.205 of the FCC rules reiterates these statutory requirements and establishes the following requirements for relinquishing an ETC designation: (1) there must be more than one ETC serving in the area of the ETC seeking relinquishment; (2) the ETC seeking relinquishment must provide advance notice to the relevant state commission; (3) the customers served by the relinquishing ETC must continue to be served by an ETC; and (4) to the extent that additional facilities are required to serve any of the relinquishing ETC's customers, sufficient notice must be provided to ensure that the construction or purchase can be timely completed.

As shown in this Application, Xiber's ETC request to relinquish its ETC designation satisfies each of these requirements.

# III. REASONS FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF HIGH COST AND LIFELINE ETC SERVICE

Xiber is seeking to relinquish its Competitive ETC designation in the State of Ohio because it was not awarded RDOF funding by the FCC in the five census blocks for which it sought the ETC designation. Although Xiber, through its parent company, was the winning bidder for those five blocks in the RDOF auction, it was unable to satisfy all of the FCC requirements to be awarded funding and will not be awarded funding for those locations. As a result, Xiber will be unable to offer the discounted broadband and voice services that it intended to offer as an ETC and no longer requires the ETC designation.

Xiber did not initiate operations in Ohio and has no High Cost or Lifeline customers in the state. As a result, there will be no impact on customers resulting from Xiber's relinquishment of its Competitive ETC designation.

#### IV. DESIGNATED SERVICE AREA

Xiber intends to relinquish its Competitive ETC designation in all areas of Ohio for which it is so designated which was comprised of five census blocks in Hardin County (*see Attachment* 2). As set forth in Section 214(e) of the Act and Section 54.205 of the FCC Rules, federal law requires the Commission to permit the withdrawal of an ETC designation for any area serviced by at least one other ETC. **Attachment 1** provides a list of companies designated ETCs statewide which could serve any potential customers that Xiber may have served had it initiated operations as an ETC.

Because Xiber has no customers, the third and fourth requirements established under the FCC rules for relinquishing ETC authority are not applicable in this instance.

#### V. CUSTOMER NOTICE

Xiber has no customers in Ohio therefore no customer notice is required.

Xiber respectfully requests the Commission grant this Application in an expedited fashion, approving relinquishment of Xiber's Competitive ETC designation in Ohio, as requested, and providing any such other relief as the Commission deems just and reasonable under the circumstances.
