On November 29, 2023, Staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Staff") filed its Report in the above captioned case. Soon after, a typographical error was observed in this report, on page 33, in the second Paragraph under the heading "FirstEnergy Transmission Planning Criteria." Staff submits this correspondence as a notification that it seeks to correct the error on p. 33, which occurs after the words, "The proposed project."

Following the words, "The proposed project," the word "VIOLATES" appears. This should be replaced with "WOULD REMEDY," and the sentence should continue as it originally appears.

The change requested on p. 33 should result in the sentence, **"The proposed project would remedy Loss of Load Criteria 11.3 which states '...the FE system will be planned and constructed such that, for any NERC Category P1 through P7 event, the associated loss of load will be limited to <300 MW.'"**
