## ENTRY

{¶ 1} On October 4, 2023, Greenlight Energy, Inc. (Greenlight) filed its renewable portfolio standard (RPS) annual compliance report for 2021 pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-05.

{¶ 2} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-05(D) provides that, if the Commission takes no action with respect to an annual compliance status report within 60 days of the filing of Staff's findings and recommendations, the report is deemed automatically approved on the 61st day after Staff's filing.

{¶ 3} On December 4, 2023, Staff filed its findings and recommendations. Therein, Staff states that Greenlight did not satisfy its 2021 RPS compliance obligation and, therefore, an alternative compliance payment is warranted. Staff recommends that the Company be directed to pay \$324.84 and file an attestation consistent with the requirements of Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-08(D). Staff further requests that this case be suspended.

{¶ 4} In order to provide additional time for the Commission and Staff to review this matter, the attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process for this case.

{¶ 5} It is, therefore,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That the automatic approval process be suspended for Greenlight's 2021 RPS annual compliance report. It is, further,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all interested persons and parties of record.
