Application Experience and Plan Description: Energia Power LLC currently serves 20 customers of electric in the state of Ohio whose combined annual usage is approximately 5,388,540.20 KWh. These customers are a combination of small business, commercial, and industrial customers. With these relationships and our knowledge of the territory, we strive to provide energy expertise and

brokerage services, for both natural gas and electric, to the business community within Ohio, and specifically in our northeast Ohio region. Electric utilities we work with, at this point in time, include: AEP Ohio, Ohio Edison, First Energy, and the Illuminating Co.,

For the upcoming renewal period, Energia Power LLC endeavors to maintain it's current customer base, and we project modest growth year over year as we continue our persuit of new customers.

Energia Power LLC does not take title to the electric as a comodity, but simply provides energy consulting

and brokering services. All contracts signed by the customer are from the certified supplier directly and not

from Energia Power LLC. All contracted services and billing are provided by the electric supplier.



Energia Power LLC does, however, maintain an office and various lines of communication (i.e., phone,

email, and website) to respond to customer inquiries, concerns or complaints, in conjunction with the

certified supplier with whom the customer has contracted for electric service. Energia Power LLC plans

to continue to operate in the manner described above.
