A-13. Company history

Stream Energy was formed in August of 2004 by co-founders Robert Snyder and Pierre Koshakji. Stream Energy was awarded its certification as a Retail Electric Provider (REP) in the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) jurisdiction of Texas by the Public Utility Commission of Texas on January 21, 2005 (REP Certificate Number: 101004).

Towards executing upon the founders' vision for effectively capturing the mass market consumer segment in ERCOT, a team of highly experienced energy experts was assembled who represent a diverse yet complimentary set of backgrounds that include, but are not limited to sales and marketing, energy procurement, scheduling and dispatch, as well as retail operational processes and systems development (i.e. electronic data transaction engine, as well as payments and billing systems). The Stream Energy management team possess well over 150 years of combined electricity and natural gas industry experience in the areas of finance, plant operations, trading and retail functions.

Since the enrollment of Stream Energy's first customer in March 2005, Stream Energy has become one of the largest Competitive Retail Electric Provider (CREP) which is a REP that was not previously associated with an incumbent utility in the ERCOT region of Texas. Stream Energy currently serves over 320,000 Texas electricity customers. In addition, Stream Energy serves electricity and gas in the states of Maryland, Pennsylvania, New York and New Jersey as well as electricity customers in the District of Columbia, Illinois and Delaware, with over 134,000 customers combined; while in Georgia Stream Energy serves over 44,000 natural gas customers.

In 2012, Stream Energy was a finalist for the Platts Global Energy awards for the 6th year in a row. Also in 2012, the Dallas Business Journal ranked Stream Energy as the 26th largest privately held company in Dallas. Stream Energy was also named the winner of Two American Business Awards. Stream Energy is also actively involved in the communities it services through charitable donations, and was named as the Top Philanthropic Donor by the Philadelphia Business Journal. In addition, Stream Energy won the 2012 Communicator Award of Distinction for highlighting Captain Hope's Kids, a non-profit advocacy group for homeless children. Stream Energy has participated in funding donations to organizations such as Utility Emergency Services Fund in Pennsylvania. n 2013, Stream Energy participated in DSA's annual Code



Communications Initiative (CCI) and received a Certificate of Recognition for its efforts in generating enhanced awareness about the Code and promoting adherence to the Code within the company and salesforce, as well as with consumers.

In 2014, Stream Energy was named the Bronze Telly Winner in the Branded Content for Promotional Branding of 'License To Thrill.'

In 2015, Direct Selling News announced that Stream ranked 9th in the 2015 North America 50. In 2016, Stream continued its philanthropic efforts by matching donations of its Associates for the Texas Tornado Benefit which helped victims of the tornadoes that struck North Texas on December 26, 2015. On April 12, 2016, Stream launched Stream Cares to strategically support and fund causes, with a special focus on giving back to members of the military and their families. In 2017, Stream was named amount the top 10 most trusted electric providers in Texas by Market Strategies International. On September 1, 2017, Stream pledged to support customers and Associates impacted by Hurricane Harvey by donating to the American Red Cross. In 2019, NRG Retail LLC ('NRG') acquired 100% of the membership interest in SGE Energy Sourcing, LLC, SGE Energy Sourcing, LLC holds 100% membership interest in Stream Energy Ohio Gas & Electric, LLC (Stream Energy).

Application Experience and Plan Description: Stream Ohio Gas and Electric, LLC ('Stream Ohio') is a wholly owned subsidiary of Stream Gas & Electric, Ltd. ('SGE'). SGE owns and operates retail entities which currently service over residential and small commercial power and/or natural gas customers in Texas, Georgia, Pennsylvania, Maryland, New Jersey, New York and District of Columbia under the dba of Stream Energy and Stream. Stream Ohio possesses the technical capability to serve customers in the Ohio electric and gas markets and comply fully with all applicable regulations governing same. The compliance will be achieved through Stream Ohio's ability to enter into working service and marketing agreements with SGE's ongoing operating entities servicing Stream Energy's current customer base.

Stream Ohio Gas & Electric, LLC ('Stream') utilizes network marketing to reach potential customers and utilizes utility consolidated billing to provide billing statements to customers. Stream has an in-house customer service team and a 3rd party outsourced team who are reachable via a toll-free phone number to respond to customer inquiries and/or complaints. Services provided by the call centers include handling calls regarding inquiries related to bills, enrollments, awards, discretionary service orders, and other routine matters. In addition, the team at Stream has worked closely with the Public Service Commissions in each state to ensure both adherence to, and contribution toward, policies and regulations that will continue to promote the competitive landscape in the states of Texas, New York, Washington D.C., Delaware, Georgia, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Illinois, and Ohio. As customer service and satisfaction are core principles of Stream's business model, Stream takes the necessary actions to ensure that it is in compliance with all regulatory requirements. Stream includes the following core principles into its business operations: • Call center management has the necessary skills and qualifications that meet Stream's standards on customer service and support for both email and call-in inquiries. This entails having a handson management team that is focused on developing, implementing, and managing the appropriate processes to ensure delivery and compliance with all rules, including providing service to any qualified applicant without discrimination, delivering the appropriate documents



to customers, and accurately communicating and adhering to customer rights policies. Call center personnel receive appropriate training to ensure knowledge of, and compliance with, all rules. In addition to initial training, representatives will be provided with additional training as needed to maintain knowledge of current rules. Floor supervisors and managers are also available to respond to emails or assist customers by phone as necessary.

- Stream has designed and implemented specific processes supporting the collection, tracking, and resolution of customer's complaints in a timely manner. Additional processes have been developed to ensure compliance of the necessary policies and timeframes. Stream has made the Anti-Discrimination Rules easily accessible by the company's employees on a regular basis.
- Stream support staff and call center employees are trained to make customers aware of the process to file a complaint with Stream and how to contact the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

Exhibit C-8. Stream Ohio Gas & Electric, LLC Corporate Structure




