{¶ 1} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.10, by Entry issued January 26, 2022, the Commission directed all regulated entities to file a 2021 annual report for fiscal assessment through the Commission's web-based filing system known as the PUCO Community by April 29, 2022. The Commission uses the annual report information to generate invoices that are then sent to the annual report filers on or before the first day of October consistent with R.C. 4905.10(B) to fund the operations of the Commission.

{¶ 2} On December 13, 2023, Michigan Southern Railroad Company, Inc. (MSOR) filed a request to file its 2021 annual report. MSOR is authorized to provide freight rail services pursuant to Certificate ID RR-MSRC. In support, MSOR states that it intended to file the report before the April 29, 2022 deadline, however, MSOR personnel made errors in their tracking log. As a result, MSOR failed to timely notify the Commission of a change to MSOR's mailing address and failed to file the annual report by the deadline. Upon approval of this motion and the unlocking of the 2021 annual report in the PUCO Community, MSOR commits to submit promptly its 2021 annual report. Further, MSOR commits to process and remit any standard assessment and the civil forfeiture assessed consistent with the June 29, 2022 Entry in a timely manner.

{¶ 3} The attorney examiner determines that MSOR's request for leave to late-file its annual report for calendar year 2021 should be granted. MSOR must now contact the Commission's Fiscal Division to make arrangements to submit its 2021 annual report for fiscal assessment.

{¶ 4} It is, therefore,

{¶ 5} ORDERED, That the motion filed by MSOR be granted in accordance with Paragraph 3. It is, further,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon MSOR.
