**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION OF HARLEM TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY,  
OHIO**

Now comes Harlem Township, Delaware County, Ohio (“Township”), by and through the undersigned counsel, which pursuant to Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), files this Notice of Intervention.

As a “public agency charged with the duty . . . of planning land use in the area in which any portion of such facility is to be located,” the Township must comply with OAC4906-2-12(A)(1) and “prepare and file with the [Ohio Power Siting Board] . . . a notice of intervention containing the following information:”

**(a) A certification or affirmation as to the legal title and authority of such official.**

The undersigned, as legal representative for the Township, affirms Harlem Township, Delaware County, Ohio is a political subdivision of the State of Ohio and operates under the laws of State of Ohio. Under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 519, the Township has adopted a Zoning Resolution which regulates and plans land use in the portion of the proposed project that crosses through the Harlem Township.

**(b) A statement demonstrating the fact that all or part of the proposed facility is to be located within the area under the jurisdiction of such official.**

On page 1, paragraph B(1) of the Applicant’s “Letter of Notification” the proposed project is listed as being located in “Berkshire, **Harlem**, Trenton townships, in Delaware County, Ohio... .” (emphasis added)

**(c) A statement indicating that such official intends to intervene in the proceedings,  
together with the grounds for which intervention is sought.**

Harlem Township has authorized the undersigned counsel to file this notice of intervention in the proceedings. The grounds for which intervention is sought is to protect the Township’s real, substantial, and unique interest in the maintenance of township land, roads, and infrastructure. The Township’s interests are not represented by any existing party. The Township’s timely intervention and participation will not cause undue delay, will not unjustly prejudice an existing party, and will contribute to the just and quick resolution of issues and concerns raised.
