MEMORANDUM INSUPPORT

On February 6, 2024, an auction was held to procure natural gas supplies for Standard Choice Offer (SCO) customers of Dominion Energy Ohio (Dominion). On the same date, the Staff filed a report concerning the results of the auction. In this report, Staff does not disclose the names of the participating and wining bidders.

Staff requests that the names of the participating and winning bidders be kept confidential for a period of fifteen days. This is necessary to protect the bidders' positions in negotiations with pipelines for the incremental capacity necessary to meet their obligations to deliver gas if chosen as a supplier. This information warrants protection as a trade secret because immediate release of this information would cause serious economic harm to the auction participants. Therefore, the Commission should grant a protective order keeping this information under seal for a period of fifteen days.
