
Dear Ohio Power Siting Board:

Large-scale, utility solar developments create a lot of noise pollution. Any issues would most likely be constrained to locations in very close proximity to the inverters. In order to provide a significant amount of electrical energy, solar facilities require large tracts of land. Many of the residential property owner's homes will be within 300' of these noisy inverters.

Solar projects fail to eliminate the "pure-tone transformer noise" and the "broadband fan noise" due to costs and therefore, the neighboring residents will continually suffer and their daily lives will be affected.

This project does not meet the public interest, convenience, and necessity and should be denied.
