
Dear Ms. Troupe:

On November 7, 2018, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) authorized Suburban Natural Gas Company (Suburban) to establish an Energy Efficiency Program (EEP) pilot program for a term of two years (commencing on or about February 2019 through February 2021) in Case No. 18-376-GA-RDR. Pursuant to the May 19, 2021 and July 27, 2022 Finding and Orders issued by the Commission, the EEP Rider was set to zero and the pilot program was extended through May 19, 2022 and again through July 27, 2023, subject to final reconciliation.

As of July 27, 2023, Suburban has a remaining balance of \$119.34 in the EEP pilot program; however, Suburban does not intend to seek continuation of the program. Therefore, given that the EEP pilot program has ended and the rider has been set to zero, Suburban requests Commission approval to terminate the EEP Rider and remove it from its tariffs. Additionally, in light of the minimal funds remaining in the program and for administrative efficiency, Suburban proposes to defer the remaining \$119.34 as a regulatory liability to be reconciled as part of Suburban's upcoming base rate case, which is currently planned for filing in early 2025. Suburban has conferred with Staff and Staff is supportive of Suburban's proposal.
