Subject: Violation of stay issued by Isabel M. Marcelletti on 12/6/2023.

PUCO,

On 4/24/2024 at 1:55PM two Duke individuals were noticed by Mr. Vonderhaar on his property located at 9594 Snider road. When approached the individuals identified themselves as Johnathan McQuide and Alac Brown from Duke. When asked if they know that there was a stay issued by PUCO on the property, they stated they were aware of the stay and that Larisa Vaysman had told them it was OK to be on the property. The individuals were then asked to leave the property, to which they complied. Both individuals walked North through the a gate onto the property located at 9500 Snider road. Shortly thereafter a white Duke truck emerged from behind the barns/buildings on the back of the property and drove east on the driveway to exit the premises.

There was no 72 hour email notice provided to Mr. Vonderhaar and no same-day notice of the work. This is a direct violation of the stay placed by Isabel M. Marcelletti on 12/6/2023 and the agreement Duke arranged with Mr. Vonderhaar in December 2011.
