ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) A settlement conference was held in this matter on June 24, 1997. At that time, discussions were held about the possibility of resolving this dispute. Counsel for the complainant was to subsequently inform the Commission regarding the complainant going forward with the complaint.
- (2) To date, the complainant has failed to provide the Commission with an update of its intentions to proceed with its complaint despite repeated unsuccessful attempts by the attorney examiner to contact the complainant regarding this matter. In addition, the attorney examiner has become aware of the fact that, due to illness, the complainant's counsel may no longer be able to continue providing representation in this matter.
- (3) In order for the Commission to determine the status of this proceeding, the complainant must file a statement with the Commission on or before Friday, September 12, 1997, indicating its intention to either proceed to hearing or withdraw the complaint. Failure to file such statement may result in the attorney examiner recommending dismissal of the complaint.
- (4) The complainant is reminded that it must pay all undisputed overdue account balances on a timely basis in order to prevent the disconnection of the associated service.




