ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On June 8, 2000, the Commission issued a decision regarding minimum requirements for door-to-door solicitation of residential customers in the three gas choice programs in Ohio. As part of that decision, the Commission instructed Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., The East Ohio Gas Company (EOG), and The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company to incorporate the conclusions into their tariffs. All three companies were instructed to file proposed tariff changes with the Commission within 10 days of the date of the decision.
- (2) On June 16, 2000, EOG filed a motion for an extension of time to incorporate the door-to-door requirements in its tariff. EOG noted that it is planning, at the end of July, to incorporate a number of changes in its tariff to accomplish the expansion of its gas choice program. EOG would like to submit door-to-door tariff revisions at the same time as the expansion tariff revisions, rather than having separate filings. EOG noted that this extension, if granted, would have no practical effect because there are no marketers in its gas choice program that currently engage in door-to-door solicitation (and, thus, would be operating without the requisite tariff language).
- (3) The examiner finds that EOG's request is reasonable and should be granted. EOG shall now submit proposed tariff revisions that appropriately incorporate the Commission's


door-to-door solicitation decision at the same time it submits revisions related to the expansion of its gas choice program system-wide.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That EOG's request for an extension of time to submit tariff revisions related to the door-to-door solicitation ruling is granted. EOG shall now submit proposed tariff revisions that appropriately incorporate the Commission's door-to-door solicitation decision at the same time it submits revisions related to the expansion of its gas choice program system-wide. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record in Case Nos. 98-594-GA-COI and 99-661-GA-COI.


