**LEGAL NOTICE**

Notice is given that a petition was filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) seeking the institution of extended area service (EAS) between, on the one hand, the Powhatan Point Exchange of Ameritech Ohio, and on the other hand, the Beallsville, Clarrington, Duffy, Martins Ferry-Bridgeport, St. Clairsville and Woodsfield exchanges of Ameritech Ohio and the Moundsville, New Martinsville, Wheeling (Zone 1) and Woodsdale Exchanges of Bell Atlantic West Virginia, Inc. The institution of EAS would permit subscribers of one exchange to place calls to and receive calls from the other exchange without being assessed message toll service charges for each call. A local community of interest hearing was convened in these cases, Case Nos. 00-796-TP-PEX and 00-797-TP-PEX, at Powhatan Point, Ohio, on February 22, 2001. Through inadvertence, public notice of that hearing was not published as required by statute. Accordingly, the Commission hereby causes publication of notice of the EAS petition. Any person desiring to present additional testimony should send a letter to the Commission. The letter should include the name address, and telephone number of the sender and a brief description of the testimony to be presented.
