

A. General (Cont'd)

9. Customers subscribing to Complete Connections Service are provided with a thirty (30)-day Customer Satisfaction Guarantee. This guarantee will provide dissatisfied customers up to a 30-day credit for the monthly charge associated with the service, less the appropriate monthly access line charge. The credit will be pro-rated based on the time the customer has the service, up to a maximum of 30 days. To receive the credit, the customer must notify the Telephone Company of their dissatisfaction with the service and place an order to discontinue the service within 30 days of the time that the service was installed. Customers will also be credited for the nonrecurring charge associated with the Custom Calling and/or Custom Calling PLUS service(s), if a nonrecurring charge was incurred.
