## **ENTRY**

- On October 7, 2003, the Governor signed Senate Bill 44 enacting (1)Section 4909.172, Revised Code, which created an infrastructure improvement surcharge mechanism for water and sewer company rates to provide a return on certain plant investment.
- On March 8, 2004, Aqua Ohio, Inc., (formerly Consumers Ohio (2) Water Company) filed an application pursuant to Section 4909.172, Revised Code, seeking to recover a system improvement charge in its Lake Erie Division.
- (3) On July 21, 2004, Aqua Ohio, Inc. filed a notice of withdrawal of its application in this case. Accordingly, this application should be dismissed and this case should be closed of record.
