The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 18, 2000, Henkin & Seewald (complainant) filed a complaint against Ameritech Ohio (Ameritech) alleging that Ameritech had failed to maintain their lines and services.
- (2) This case should be set for a prehearing conference on February 27, 2001, at 10:00 p.m., Room 11C, at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of the settlement conference is to determine whether this matter can be resolved informally. In the event that a settlement is not reached at the conference, the attorney examiner will conduct a discussion of procedural issues at the conclusion of the settlement conference. Procedural issues for discussion may include discovery dates, possible stipulations of facts, and potential hearing dates.


It is, therefore,
