DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE SERVICE

Local Calling Area

A. General

1. The Telephone Company furnishes a service whereby customers may obtain assistance in determining a telephone numbers by calling the Directory Assistance number or "0" operator subject to the regulations and charges shown herein.
2. Charges for Directory Assistance Service apply when customers of the Telephone Company request assistance in determining telephone numbers of parties who are located in the same local service area.

B. Rates

1. For each direct dialed call to Directory Assistance with no monthly allowance

<u>Residential Rate</u>	<u>Business Rate</u>
\$0.61	\$0.85
2. For each call, with no monthly allowance, to Directory Assistance placed through the "0" Operator

<u>Residential Rate</u>	<u>Business Rate</u>
\$0.68	\$0.98

C. Conditions

1. A maximum of two requested telephone numbers is provided with each Directory Assistance call.
2. Call allowances are not transferable between separate services of the same individual or firm.

D. Exemptions

1. Charges for Directory Assistance Service are not applicable to calls placed from
  - Public or Semi-public telephones;
  - Hotel and Motels;
  - Hospitals; or by
  - Customers who certify that they are unable to use a directory because of a visual or physical handicap.

E. Call Allowance

1. An allowance of one (1) direct dialed Directory Assistance call per month, at no charge, will be made for
  - Each Main Station Line, PBX Central Office Trunk, Mobile Telephone Unit or Outward WATS Access Line;
  - Each group of eight Centrex Stations; or
  - Each PBX Dormitory or Centrex Dormitory Station.
