EXHIBIT C – DESCRIPTION OF REVISIONS

With this application Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC is proposing to decrease the monthly rates associated with the deluxe Centrex lines. The rationale for this change in rates is to increase the gap between the rates associated with a shorter contract term and a longer contract term, thus making it more attractive to customers to sign a longer-term contract.

Per CBT's Elective Alternative Regulation Plan a rate change within the approved range to a Tier 1 service is subject to a 0-day filing. Therefore, this filing will be effective upon filing.
