ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 13, 2004, Gregory and Tina Sobczak (complainants) filed a complaint with the Commission. Complainants alleged that Seneca Utilities Company, Inc. (Seneca) wrongfully applied a tariff and billed them for water service to the family garage.
- (2) On December 9, 2004, complainants filed a notice of withdrawal with prejudice. In the notice, complainants state that Seneca has resolved the complaint to their satisfaction and, for that reason, they are voluntarily withdrawing their complaint.
- (3) Inasmuch as the complaint has been resolved to the complainants' satisfaction, this case should be dismissed.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 04-1283-WW-CSS be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

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
ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


