ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Columbus Southern Power Company (Columbus Southern) and South Central Power Company (South Central) are electric suppliers as defined in Section 4933.81, Revised Code.
- (2) Certification by the Commission of the territories of Columbus Southern and South Central was approved by Entries dated June 3, and April 8, 1981 in Case No. 78-1311-EL-ORD.
- (3) Columbus Southern and South Central have jointly petitioned the Commission to reallocate their service territories. Specifically, they request the following relocation:

On quadrangle map U-11-Hillsboro, relocate the existing boundary line in Washington Township, Highland County, Ohio, beginning at a point where the existing boundary line intersects the center line of New Market Road; thence 1300 feet northerly along existing boundary line; thence 3100 feet westerly along John Smart's and Van Smart's south property line; thence 1200 feet northerly along Van Smart's west property line; thence 2600 feet easterly along Van Smart's north property line to where it intersects the center line of McDonald Lane; thence along the center line of McDonald Lane to where it intersects the existing boundary line.

- (4) In support of their request, the petitioners state that a new customer in South Central's territory has requested service. Due to the distance from South Central's facilities, it is not practical for South Central to provide service to the customer. Columbus Southern is able and willing to serve the new customer. Additionally, the property line of the only customer in overlap "A" on PUCO Map No. U-11, which is served by Columbus

Southern in South Central's territory, is located between the property of the new customer requesting service and the existing boundary line. The reallocation of territory will result in both customers being located in Columbus Southern's territory and being served by Columbus Southern, and the elimination of the existing overlap "A."

- (5) Section 4933.83 (E), Revised Code, provides in pertinent part:

Notwithstanding the effectuation of certified territories established by or pursuant to Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90 of the Revised Code, and the exclusive right of electric suppliers to serve within such territory, and notwithstanding any other provisions of such sections establishing rights of electric suppliers to furnish electric service, any two or more electric suppliers may jointly petition the Commission for the reallocation of their own territories and electric load centers among them and designating which portions of such territories and electric load centers are to be served by each of the electric suppliers.

- (6) The Staff has reviewed this petition and recommends approval of the boundary line relocation described in Finding (3).
- (7) No exception to the change described in Finding (3) has been brought to the Commission's attention.
- (8) The Commission finds that granting the requested relief will promote the purposes of Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90, Revised Code, and will further promote the provision of adequate service to all territories and electric load centers affected by the relocation. Accordingly, the Commission shall order the appropriate modification of the territorial boundary of Columbus Southern and South Central.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request of Columbus Southern and South Central to relocate their territory boundary is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the change on quadrangle map U-11-Hillsboro, described in Finding (3), be approved to show the boundary line change. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.




