ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On February 1, 2005, Albert Long filed a complaint against The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company (CG&E). In his complaint, Mr. Long alleged that CG&E has improperly billed his prior account for gas and electric charges.
- (2) On February 22, 2005, CG&E filed its answer, denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) Accordingly, this case should be scheduled for a prehearing conference on April 8, 2005, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11<sup>th</sup> floor, Hearing Room 11-B, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (4) The purpose of the prehearing conference is to explore the parties' willingness to negotiate a resolution of this complaint in lieu of an evidentiary hearing. An attorney examiner from the Commission's legal department will facilitate the settlement process; however, nothing prohibits any party from initiating settlement negotiations prior to the scheduled conference. The parties should bring to the conference all documents relevant to this matter.

- (5) In the event that a settlement is not reached at the conference, the attorney examiner will conduct a discussion of procedural issues at the conclusion of the conference. Procedural issues for discussion may include discovery dates, possible stipulations of facts and potential hearing dates.
- (6) The attorney examiner further finds that the industry code in this case should be corrected to "GE" since this complaint addresses both gas and electric service.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


