On June 25, 2001, Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. (GCTI, the Company) requested the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's approval to remove Centrex Service from its tariff and to cease providing it to the Company's customers. At the time of the filing, the GCTI product management group had hoped to move more quickly with the Centrex conversion project. However, after further analysis, a longer timeframe was established.

Therefore, GCTI respectfully requests that the Commission allow the Company to withdraw its June 25, 2001 filing, Case No. 01-1515-TP-ATA.
