

#### CENTREX SERVICE

#### A. GENERAL (Cont'd)

- Auxiliary equipment and other services compatible with Centrex service may be furnished at the rates specified in the applicable sections of this tariff.
- 4. The rates and charges shown below apply to standard installations of this service designed by the Telephone Company. Where a customer requires a special type of installation or when the conditions imposed by the customer, such as time and place involved make the installation abnormally or excessively costly, charges equal to the estimated cost will apply.
- 5. Where quantities of switching equipment or exchange access lines in excess of those considered standard by the Telephone Company are requested, the additional facilities will be furnished at rates and charges based on costs incurred.
- 6. All operating at the customer's premises is performed at the expense of the customer and must conform with rules and regulations of the Telephone Company to maintain a proper standard of service.
- 7. Supplemental residence service is available for colleges, universities and similar educational institutions.
- 8. Centrex service is a discontinued service offering. Rates and regulations apply only to Centrex Systems in service and to subsequent additions to and service feature changes in such systems (Note) where in the opinion of the Telephone Company it is feasible to do so and does not require a change-out of equipment.

Centrex Service will be withdrawn six months after the approval date of this proceeding. Existing subscribers to Centrex Service may transfer to Centrex 2000 Service without incurring termination liabilities and, in addition, the non-recurring charges will be waived for an equal number of lines. Current month-to-month subscribers may retain Centrex Service for six months from the approval date. At that time, these subscribers must disconnect their Centrex Service and transfer to another service. Variable term payment subscribers will be able to retain Centrex Service until their respective payment periods expire.

Note: Subsequent and service feature changes include the addition of stations at existing locations, the establishment of new secondary locations, the change in designation from primary location to secondary location and vice versa, and the move of a primary location from one premises to another.
