ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) On June 14, 2001, Rondy, Inc. (Complainant) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Respondent) in this docket alleging that Respondent has charged it unjust and unreasonable rates for electric service.
- (2) Respondent filed its answer and a motion to dismiss this case on July 3, 2001.
- (3) By Entry dated July 12, 2001, the Attorney Examiner assigned to this case scheduled this matter for a settlement conference to be held on July 31, 2001, at the offices of the Commission. The parties were unable to settle this matter at that time.
- (4) Various Attorney Examiners assigned to this case have attempted without success to contact Complainant through its legal counsel to determine whether this case has been settled or whether Complainant wishes to have a hearing on the merits of the case.
- (5) If Complainant still wants the Commission to have a hearing in this matter, it should notify the Commission in writing by the close of business on June 7, 2002 at the following address:


