This is in response to correspondence from your office dated May 30, 2000 (received June 5) transmitting the report titled "Report for Phase I Archaeology Survey of 2.65 Miles (4.27 km) along West Chester Road and Union Center Boulevard, Union Township, Butler County, Ohio" by Jeannine Kreinbrink, May 19, 2000. The comments of the Ohio Historic Preservation Office (OHPO) are submitted in accordance with provisions of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (16 U.S.C. 470 [36 CFR 800]).

The report documents an intensive survey of the project area. The survey included background review, pedestrian walk-over, and shovel testing. The emphasis for this survey was the documentation of the extent of disturbance within the project right-of-way. The survey resulted in the delineation of extensive disturbance but also reported several areas with less disturbance or buried soils. No properties were identified. Based on the information presented in the report, it is my opinion that there will be no historic properties affected by the proposed project. No further coordination with this office is necessary for this project unless there is a change in the scope of work. In addition, if new or additional properties are discovered, this office should be notified [36 CFR 800.13].
