## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 1, 2002, John M. Reichardt (Complainant), filed a complaint against The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L, Respondent) alleging that Respondent incorrectly and unlawfully billed Complainant for electric usage to his residence.
- (2) The Attorney Examiner assigned to this case issued an entry on March 22, 2002 setting this matter for a settlement conference to be held on April 4, 2002. The Attorney Examiner subsequently granted a continuance of the date for the settlement conference at the request of Respondent to April 11, 2002.
- (3) On April 10, 2002, the parties filed a joint motion noting that they had reached an agreement resolving the issues raised in this case and requesting that the case be dismissed.
- (4) There being no issues remaining to be resolved, the joint motion to dismiss this case should be granted and Case No. 02-549-EL-CSS should be closed as a matter of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint motion of the parties filed on April 10, 2002, requesting that this case be dismissed be granted and that this case be closed as a matter of record. It is, further,
