ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company (CG&E) and South Central Power Company (South Central) are electric suppliers as defined in Section 4933.81, Revised Code.
- (2) Certification by the Commission of the territories of CG&E and South Central was approved by Entries dated May 22, 1981, and May 8, 1981, in Case No. 78-1311-EL-ORD.
- (3) CG&E and South Central have jointly petitioned the Commission to reallocate their service territories in Jackson Township, Clermont County, Ohio. Specifically, they request the following relocation:

On quadrangle map V-7-Williamsburg, include an overlap Area "A", one address served by South Central in CG&E's certified territory.

- (4) In support of their request, the petitioners state that a new customer located in CG&E's service territory has requested service from them. Due to the new home being inaccessible to CG&E facilities, it is not practicable for CG&E to provide service to the customer. South Central is able and willing to serve the new customer.
- (5) Section 4933.83 (E), Revised Code, provides in pertinent part:

Notwithstanding the effectuation of certified territories established by or pursuant to Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90 of the Revised Code, and the exclusive right of electric suppliers to serve within such territory, and notwithstanding any other provisions of such sections establishing rights of electric suppliers to furnish electric service, any two or more electric suppliers may jointly petition the Commission for the reallocation of their own territories and electric load centers among them and designating which portions of such territories and electric load centers are to be served by each of the electric suppliers.

- (6) The Staff has reviewed this petition and recommends approval of the boundary line reallocation described in Finding (3).
- (7) No exception to the change described in Finding (3) has been brought to the Commission's attention.
- (8) The Commission finds that granting the requested relief will promote the purposes of Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90, Revised Code, and will further promote the provision of adequate service to all territories and electric load centers affected by the relocation. Accordingly, the Commission shall order the appropriate modification of the territorial boundary of CG&E and South Central.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request of CG&E and South Central to relocate their territory boundary is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the change on quadrangle map V7 -Williamsburg, described in Finding (3), be approved to show the boundary line change. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
