#### ACCELERATED MAIN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM RIDER

#### **APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to all customers receiving service under the Company's sales and transportation rate schedules.

#### **ACCELERATED MAIN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM FACTORS**

All customers receiving service under Rate RS, Rate RFT, Rate GS, Rate FT and Rate DGS shall be assessed a monthly charge in addition to the Customer Charge component of their applicable rate schedule that will enable the Company to complete the bare steel/cast iron main replacement program. Customers receiving service under, Rate IT and Rate SSIT will be assessed a throughput charge in addition to their commodity delivery charge, for that purpose. The maximum monthly Rider AMRP charge for any customers' Rate IT throughput, shall be \$500.00 per account.

Rider AMRP will be updated annually, in order to reflect the impact on the Company's revenue requirements of net plant additions as offset by operations and maintenance expense reductions during the most recent twelve months ended December. Such adjustments to the Rider will become effective with the first billing cycle of May, and during the first year will reflect the allocation of the required revenue increase based on the revenue distribution approved in the Company's last rate proceeding. In subsequent years, the allocation will be made on the basis of the actual base revenues excluding Rider AMRP revenues by rate class for the just completed calendar year. New allocations will be contained within the Company's annual filings.

Such adjustments to the Rider will become effective with the first billing cycle of May, and during the first year will reflect the allocation of the required revenue increase based on the revenue distribution approved in the Company's last rate proceeding. In subsequent years, the allocation will be made on the basis of the actual base revenues excluding Rider AMRP revenues by rate class for the just completed calendar year. New allocations will be contained within the Company's annual filings.

This letter is to inform you that The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company (CG&E) will file an application for an increase in rates with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) in December, 2003. The application will propose an increase in rates of approximately \$6.8 million dollars for Rider AMRP – Accelerated Main Replacement Program Rider for CG&E's gas distribution service to be effective in May, 2004. This increase will result in an additional charge of \$1.00 per month for residential customers and represents an increase in CG&E's gas rates of approximately 1.4%, based on a previously negotiated cap for this rate, agreed to by the interested parties in a Stipulation and Recommendation and approved by the Commission in an Opinion and Order dated May 30, 2001 in In the Matter of the Application of The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company for an Increase in Rates, Case No. 01-1228-GA-AIR.

Under its Accelerated Main Replacement Program, CG&E is installing plastic mains and service lines to replace the cast iron and bare steel mains and metallic service lines throughout its service territory in an accelerated time period. When CG&E embarked on this program in 2001, it had approximately 1,000 miles of cast iron mains and 192 miles of bare steel mains. These mains were aged, with some dating back to circa 1873, and are much less reliable than plastic pipe. This program will significantly reduce CG&E's operation and maintenance expenses and will enable CG&E to operate its distribution system at higher pressures, which will provide benefits such as reduced water infiltration into the gas mains. CG&E projects that, by the end of 2003, it will have approximately 756 miles of cast iron mains and 172

miles of bare steel mains in its distribution system. In an Opinion and Order dated May 30, 2001 in In the Matter of the Application of The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company for an Increase in Rates, Case No. 01-Stipulation approved a Commission 1228-GA-AIR, the Recommendation providing for CG&E to file for such annual increases to recover the cost of this program through 2007.

I have enclosed a list of the proposed new rates. These rates are subject to change after the Commission holds public evidentiary hearings. While this letter is a formal notice to you, in accordance with Ohio public utility law, we also have representatives available to discuss our rate proposal. If you have any questions about our rate proposal, please call our Rates Department at (513) 287-3302 and we will respond to your inquiries.

If you have other questions regarding our service, please call your Cinergy/CG&E customer service manager. As always, we value your role as our customers and as the elected representatives of the communities we serve.
