ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 2, 1995, Teresa Wills, spokesperson for the complainants, and numerous other subscribers of the Kingston Exchange of The Chillicothe Telephone Company ("CTC") filed a petition which seeks the institution of two-way, nonoptional, flat-rate extended area service (EAS) between the Kingston Exchange and the Circleville and Laurelville exchanges of GTE North Incorporated ("GTE").
- (2) Following the settlement conference which occurred in this case, the spokesperson for the complainants has indicated to the attorney examiner that she is no longer interested in pursuing this matter further. Therefore, unless another petitioner from the involved exchanges files in this docket, by no later than April 12, 1998, a letter expressing his or her willingness both to proceed further in this matter and also to act as a spokesperson for the complainants, this case will be automatically dismissed, and closed of record, on April 13, 1998. occurs, it shall in no way preclude anyone from filing, at any time in the future, a new petition requesting EAS between these same exchanges.


It is, therefore,






