On October 6, 1994, the Ohio Gas Company filed a Motion for Approval of A Special Arrangement For Transportation Service, and Pre-Granted Termination for the following contracts: Ohio Cellular Products, Inc.; Schmidt Brothers, Inc.; ITT Higbie, Fulton Division; BASF Corporation; Bard Manufacturing Company; American National Can Company; and Chase Brass & Copper Company. On April 11, 1996, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio issued a Finding and Order in Case No. 94-1606-GA-AEC approving the contracts and pre-approving termination.

In accordance with the Commission's April 11, 1996 authorization, this letter serves as notice that the Ohio Cellular Products, Inc. contract has been terminated. 
