

SBC Ohio proposes to revise Parts 15 and 20, Sections 5 and 15, respectively of its SBC Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 20, to correct an error made in an earlier filing which grandfathered the Ameritech Fiber Distributed Data Interface ("FDDI") service. In that earlier filing, Part 15, Section 4, Sheet 7 was inadvertently not included in that filing.
