L. AT&T Long Distance Wireless Service

1. General

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AT&T Long Distance Wireless Service is a consumer telecommunications service offering which permits outbound calling from users of cellular or Personal Communications Service (PCS) telephones. Rates, regulations and material in this section are for two-point intrastate service only, and apply to Dial Station, Customer dialed 1+ calls only. Rates and regulations for Calling Card and operator assisted message services are as specified in Section 6 of this tariff. This service is offered in conjunction with, and is described within AT&T's Tariff F.C.C. No. 27.

2. Availability

AT&T Long Distance Wireless Service is available to customers who obtain either cellular access from cellular service providers on either the A-side or B-side or PCS access from PCS providers, and Mobile Identification Numbers as defined in AT&T's Tariff F.C.C. No. 27. AT&T Long Distance Wireless Service is subject to billing availability.

AT&T is not responsible if communications cannot be established or maintained due to cellular access or PCS access or because of adverse atmospheric or other like limitations.

3. Rates and Charges#

For Dial Station calls, if the computed charges include a fraction of a cent, the fraction is rounded down to the next whole cent when the fractional charge is less than 5 mills and is rounded up to the next whole cent when the fractional charge is 5 mills or greater.
