EXTENDED LOCAL CALLING SERVICE (ELCS)

A. GENERAL

- Extended Local Calling Service (ELCS) is a two-way non-optional three element measured rate service that provides for the completion of local messages between customers located in different exchanges when ordered by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO).
- 2. ELCS is available with all classes of service.
- All Extended Area Service (EAS) existing prior to the establishment of ELCS will continue in its present form unless discontinued by the PUCO.

B. RATES

 ELCS is provided at the following per minute rates for each completed call.

B. RATES (Continued)

3. Charges for ELCS calls are based upon three measured elements, i.e., frequency (the total number of outgoing completed calls), the duration of each call and the time of day each call is originated, subject to the following:

a. Duration

- Call connection rates for connection of each completed call, which includes the initial minute.
- 2) Minutes of use rates are for each minute, or any fraction thereof, that the connection continues. (Fractions of minutes will be rounded to the next full minute.)
- 3) Chargeable time is started when the called party answers or when the caller is connected to automatic answering services, i.e., automatic answer/record equipment, voice mail, or an answering service.
- 4) Chargeable time ends when the calling station "hangs up", thereby releasing the network connection. If the called station "hangs up" but the calling station does not, chargeable time ends when the network connection is released by automatic timing equipment in the telephone network.
- 5) Chargeable time does not include time lost because of faults or defects in the service.

b. Time of Day

- 1) Holiday rates apply on Christmas Day (December 25), New Year's Day (January 1), Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day, and Thanksgiving.
- 2) In cases where a call begins in one rate period and ends in antoher, the rate in effect at the time the connection is established applies to the entire message.
