Please be advised that starting with the above-captioned EAS proceeding, on a going-forward basis, the calling statistics which have formerly been reported separately by MCI and WorldCom will now be combined into one report. An affidavit is being filed in this case which reflects this change.

The MCI WorldCom long distance operations were combined into one entity, MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. in Case Nos. 99-696-CT-ZCN, 99-697-TP-ACN and 99-698-TP-ATR on September 23, 1999. However, MCI WorldCom did not have the technical capability to report calling statistics between exchanges on a combined basis until now.
